I was asked to share this once again. Recycling is an earth friendly activity and part of our stewardship of God's creation. It's even better is when our recycling efforts help other organizations in our community- a double blessing. There are several ways that our Teens & Tweens class (led by Pat McCoy) is helping us do just that.

- **Aluminum Pop Cans-** Bring your pop cans and give them to Pat McCoy. The class will recycle them and all proceeds received will be used to purchase something from Heifer Project International to send to someone in need. The class has not chosen their animal/resource.
- **Pop/Pull Tabs-** You can place baggies of pop tabs in the offering plate or leave them attached to the pop cans you give the youth. These will be given to the United Methodist Women who collect them for Ronald McDonald House.
- **Labels for Education, Box Tops for Education, and Best Choice Barcodes-** These are found on all kinds of products including Campbell's Soup, Post Cereals, Frozen Foods, Bic, bakeware, and clothing just to name a few. Check everything! Place these in the offering plate and these will be given to organizations that benefit from them, most often schools and outreach ministries.
- **Country Mart Receipts-** Supports Apples for Education which provides schools with supplies and equipment. Deposit in receptacles at Country Mart or place in offering plate.
