Can These Dry Bones REALLY Live?

When we were young, many of us learned the song:

Ezekiel cried, "Dem dry bones!"

If we learned the song, and even the story of Ezekiel and the valley of the dry bones (Ezekiel 37:-14), when we were young, our imaginations might have still been active enough to imagine the Lord bringing the bones back together and coming to life. Many of us had few experiences that would have made us question the power of God to do such miraculous things.

Sometimes, though, as we have aged it gets harder to imagine such events, to believe that God has such power- to renew the dry bones, to raise the dead, or even to heal the sick. It isn't that we don't want to believe in God's power, but our life experiences have given us a frame of reference for such things. We've seen few miracles. We've prayed for healing that doesn't come. We've had our own struggles and challenges. And, we hear the world, and even other Christians blame God or even claim we have a lack of faith because we experience these things.

Sometimes our spirits, begin to feel parched and beaten like those dry bones. We don't feel like we are living, really. And we are desperate for God to speak into our lives like he did to the valley of the dry bones and like God did through Jesus to Lazarus. And, most often God does. God speaks into our lives and into our spirits through prayer, scripture, and community. Through unexpected blessings and words of comfort and support. Sometimes, when we are in the midst of the dry places of life, we miss God speaking because it comes in unexpected ways. But God still speaks and brings us to life. True life.
